Gloria Molina

Chair

Los Angeles County Board of Supervisors

Starting as a Hispanic activist in the 1970s, she has served since 1991 as a supervisor for the nation's most populous county. More than 10 million people live in the county; about 44.6 percent are Hispanic. On the board, Ms. Molina ended the county's practice of pension spiking, saving taxpayers nearly \$100 million. She has allocated more than \$10 million to Parks & Recreation capital projects.

Hector Motroni **Senior Vice-President & Chief Ethics Officer** **Xerox**

Mr. Motroni directs human resources, ethics and compliance, risk management, public relations, corporate communi-



cations, facilities, real estate, and general services for the copier company. He serves on the company's Strategy Committee and chairs the Xerox Political Action Committee. Previously he held a series of executive positions, including vice-president in the Xerox Worldwide Marketing Group and director of planning for the Latin American region.

Frankie Muniz

Actor

The star of Fox sitcom *Malcolm in the Middle* lent his voice to the main character Stripes in this year's animated film *Racing Stripes*. In 2004 he

starred in the film *Agent Cody Banks 2: Destination London*, a sequel to 2003's *Agent Cody Banks*. The 19-year-old actor's upcoming film, *Stay Alive*, is slated for a spring 2006 release. *Malcolm* has won Emmy, Grammy, and American Comedy Awards.

Henry R. Muñoz **Vice-Chair** **Smithsonian National Board**

He spearheaded the capital campaign to restore San Antonio's Alameda Theatre, forming an affiliation with the Smithsonian. Mr. Muñoz is a successful entrepreneur with Kell Muñoz Architects, the largest minority-owned



architectural firm in Texas. His designs emphasize Mestizo regionalism, incorporating the traditions and culture of the Texas/Mexico border region. Mr. Muñoz was founding president of Texas Public Radio and has raised more than \$2 million for scholarships.



Enrique Murciano **Actor**

Since 2002 he has played FBI agent Danny Taylor in the CBS drama *Without a Trace*. This year Mr. Murciano appeared in the comedy film *Miss Congeniality 2: Armed and Fabulous*. He also has a role in Andy Garcia's upcoming directorial debut film *The Lost City*. Mr. Murciano made his feature film debut in *Traffic* and also appeared in *Black Hawk Down*. »
